- Asses and survey the existing sanitation condition of the 6 towns, which is required for selection of the best suitable option in line with the new socio economic development of the project area and other factors;
- Assess relevant international practices in urban sanitation management and implementation particularly in developing countries (similar scenarios to Ethiopia),
- The consultant will be in charge of preparing feasibility study with detail sanitation Master Plan (s) for 6 towns
 and recommend feasible sanitation intervention options for each towns which will then further refined in details
 by an external consultant. The feasibility study shall recommend the tariff setup for the new sanitation
 intervention of the 6 towns considering the long term loan financing;
- Review and customize the existing WRDF On-lending agreement for urban sanitation projects loan financing;
- Establish a Urban Sanitation Unit at WRDF and Town Water Utilities/Regional water Bureaus;
- Prepare capacity building proposal with training material then conduct the training for WRDF and selected Town
 Water Utilities/Regional water bureaus, recommend the external training and experience sharing for the
 sanitation program. The capacity building recommendation/proposal has to include the material requirement
 both WRDF and Utility level;
- Give technical support to WRDF during hiring process of external consultant who prepare final feasibility study and detail design;
- The consultant is expected to support the WRDF Sanitation Unit in key moments of the programme implementation as required, including but not limited to the areas of programme audit requirement, safe guard requirements, monitoring checklist drafting and midterm review, setting up programme performance indicators.

The short listing criteria are:

- core business and years in business;
- qualification and experience in the field of assignment;
- · organizational, managerial and technical capabilities of the firm; and
- General qualification and number of key staff, but not individual experts' bio data.
